AND WHEREAS the workman has filed an application under section 10 of the Industrial Dispute Act, 1947 (14of 1947) to the Seventh Industrial Tribunal specified for this purpose under this Deptt.'s Notification No. 1085-IR/12L-9/95 dated 25.07.1997.

AND WHEREAS, the Seventh Industrial Tribunal heard the parties under section 10(1B) (d) of the I.D. Act, 1947 (14of 1947) and framed the following issue dismissal of the workman as the "issue" of the dispute.

# AWARD

## DATED, 14/08/2023

Today is fixed for passing order in respect of the joint petition for compromise dated 10.08.2023, filed by both the parties.

The case record is taken up for passing order.

Perused the joint compromise petition, Memorandum of Settlement (Exbt. B), both dated 10.08.2023, petition U/s 10 of the Industrial Disputes Act, 1947 (as amended) as well as evidence of the applicant Sri Rameswar Behara (P.W.1) and Ms. Shalu Sharma (O.P.W.1), authorized representative of the Company namely M/s. Kejriwal Castings Ltd, so adduced in support of said compromise petition and also Exbt. A (authorization letter dated 04.03.2023).

It appears from the evidence of P.W.1 and O.P.W.1 that the matter in dispute has already been settled in between the parties in terms of Memorandum of Settlement dated 10.08.2023 , as mentioned in the compromise petition dated 10.08.2023. I further find from the said Memorandum of Settlement as well as from the evidence of both parties that the Company has issued two account payee cheques in favour of applicant, Rameswar Behara - one being No. 004867 dated 04.03.2023 drawn on HDFC Bank, Stephen House, Kolkata of Rs. 1,50,000/- (One lakh fifty thousand) only and another one being No. 058563 dated 04.03.2023 drawn on ICICI Bank, Chowringhee Road Branch of Rs. 46,010/- (Forty six thousand and ten) only and handed over the same to the applicant as settled amount and the said two cheques has already been credited to the Bank Account of the applicant and the applicant (P.W.1) has no grievance against the O.P./Company at present. Considered.

Yeventh Madage

The joint compromise petition and Memorandum of Settlement both dated 10.08.2023 have duly been signed by the applicant, Sri Rameswar Behara (P.W.1) and Ms. Shalu Sharma (O.P.W.1) representing on behalf of the O.P./Company voluntarily. Since the matter has already been settled between the parties to the proceedings, I am of the view that this Tribunal should not stand in the way of their such settlement/compromise, which appears to be legal and valid, and so, this Tribunal finds no impediment in allowing such prayer, made jointly by the parties voluntarily.

Hence, it is

### Ordered

That the joint compromise petition dated 10.08.2023 is allowed and accordingly, the proceedings under Section 10 of the Industrial Disputes Act, 1947, as amended, be and the same is disposed of in terms of the Memorandum of Settlement dated 10.08.2023. The joint petition of compromise and Memorandum of Settlement, both dated 10.08.2023, be made part of the Award.
