It appears from the evidence of P.W.1 and O.P.W.1 that the matter in dispute has already been settled in between the parties in terms of Memorandum of Settlement dated 03.05.2024 (Exbt. B), I further find from the said Memorandum of Settlement as well as from the evidence of both parties that the Company has issued A/c payee cheques being Nos. 102235 of Rs.1,00,000/- and 102236 dated 03.05.2024 of Rs. 50,000/- respectively totaling Rs. 1,50,000/- (One lakh fifty thousand only) drawn on Bank of Maharashta, Chitaranjan Avenue Branch, Kolkata to the applicant as full and final settlement amount and the applicant has issued a money receipt of the same, marked as Exbt. 1 and the said cheques were handed over to the applicant as full and final settled amount and the amount of settlement has already been credited to the Bank Account of the applicant and the applicant (P.W.1) has no grievance against the O.P./Company at present. Xerox copies of Cheques has been marked as Exbts. C & D respectively. An original money receipt has been given to the O.P. to that effect ((Exbt. 1). The Memorandum of Settlement filed by the parties dated 03.05.2024 has duly been signed by the applicant, Sri Mahadev Ghosh (P.W.1) and Mr. Dipak Kumar Pandey (O.P.W.1) representing on behalf of the O.P./Company voluntarily.
