# A W A R D DATED, 31/03/2023

This Industrial Dispute between M/s. Development Research Communication and Service Centre, 58A, Dharmatolla Road, Bosepukur, Kasba, Kolkata – 700 042 and Sri Kashinath Ghosh, 55/2, K.K.M. Road, Santoshpur, Kolkata – 700 075 has been transferred from Labour Department, I.R. Branch, New Secretariat Buildings (12<sup>th</sup> Floor), 1, Kiran Sankar Roy Road, Kolkata – 700 001 to the 7<sup>th</sup> Industrial Tribunal by the Govt. of West Bengal, Labour Department's Vide G. O. No. Labr./1021/(LC-IR)/IR/11L-68/17, dated 18/10/2017 vide Notification No. 3115-IR/IR/3A-6/59 dated 21/06/1960 for the purpose of adjudication upon the under mentioned issues-

## **ISSUES**

- (1) Whether the termination of service of Kashinath Ghosh by way of refusal of employment with effect from 16/02/2016 by the management of M/s. Development Research Communication and Service Centre is justified?
- (2) What relief, if any the workman is entitled to?

Thereafter this case was further transferred before this Tribunal vide G. O. No.Labr./699/(LC-IR)/23099/15/2019 dated 26/07/2019 and this Tribunal had received this case record on 01/08/2019.

Originally the case record was fixed for further argument of workman on 14/03/2023, but on that day both the parities filed a joint petition and submitted that both the parties have agreed among themselves to settle the disputes and to that effect they like to file a memorandum of settlement before this Tribunal. Date was fixed on 30/03/2023 for hearing of proposed settlement petition. On 30/03/2023 they have filed a memorandum of settlement duly signed by both the parties and also two affidavits in chief one of Sri Kashinath Ghosh i.e. the workman of this case and another of Sri Samir Bhattacharya who has represented the company i.e. M/s. Development Research Communication and Service Centre. They also filed one joint petition praying for proceeding the case for settlement in terms of the Memorandum of Settlement. They also prayed for dispose of the case as per terms and conditions of the Memorandum of Settlement. Both the parties are present along with their Ld. Advocates. Ld. Advocate for M/s. Development Research Communication and Service Centre, submitted that they have no objection if the instant case is disposed off on the basis of the terms and conditions of the Memorandum of Settlement.

Both the Ld. Advocates of the parties jointly submitted that the dispute between the parties in the present case has been amicably settled out of Court / Tribunal and to that effect a memorandum of settlement dated 30/03/2023 has prepared by both the parties and the parties also finalized their disputes in terms of the memorandum of the settlement. In view of the above facts and circumstances both the parties prayed for disposal of the case in terms of memorandum of settlement dated 30/03/2023.

In support of their contention the workman Sri Kashinath Ghosh examined himself as PW-1, who was the workman of M/s. Development Research Communication and Service Centre and the memorandum of settlement is marked as Exhibit-1 and the photocopies of his Aadhaar and PAN Card of Sri Kashinath Ghosh are marked as Exhibit-2 and Exhibit-3 respectively. He also admitted and agreed with the terms and condition of the Memorandum of Settlement and prays for disposal of the case in view of the Terms and Conditions of the Memorandum of settlement and his cross examination is declined by the Ld. Advocate of M/s. Development Research Communication and Service Centre.

On the contrary one of the Treasurer of M/s. Development Research Communication and Service Centre namely Sri Samir Kumar Bhattacharya examined himself as MW-1 and the photocopy of authorization dated 30/03/2023 of M/s. Development Research Communication and Service Centre is marked as Exhibit-A and the photocopy of High Court Bar Association Identity Card is marked as Exhibit-B and the photocopy of Bank Draft dated 27/03/2023 of Axis Bank is marked as Exhibit-C and he has categorically stated about the settlement by and between the parties and he also stated that the management of M/s. Development Research Communication and Service Centre has no objection if the present case is disposed off as per terms and conditions of the settlement petition and practically the management of M/s. Development Research Communication and Service Centre also prays for dispose off the case on the basis of the terms and condition of the settlement petition and his cross-examination is also declined by the Ld. Advocate for the workman.

This Tribunal has carefully examined the terms and condition of the memorandum of settlement and also has scrutinized the signatures appeared in the memorandum of settlement by both the parties.

It reveals that the management of M/s. Development Research Communication and Service Centre duly authorized vide Authorization Certificate dated 30/03/2023 empowered to Sri Samir Kumar Bhattacharya to sign and execute the terms of settlement between the parties and accordingly Sri Samir Kumar Bhattacharya put his signatures upon the same and the workman Sri Kashinath Ghosh also signed upon the same about knowing its contents. It further reveals that the management has paid Rs. 5,00,000/- (Rupees Five Lakhs only) to the petitioner Sri Kashinath Ghosh through Bank Draft of Axis Bank, Prince Anwarshah Road, Kolkata, vide Bank Draft No. 029061 dt. 27/03/2023 which has been admitted by the petitioner to Sri Kashinath Ghosh in his examination-in-chief.

Having regard to the facts and circumstances and considering the materials on records and the terms of the settlement, this Tribunal is of the opinion that the terms and conditions of the settlement dated 30/03/2023 by and between the parties of this case are legally valid and proper.

There is no legal impediment to accept the terms and condition of the settlement and to dispose off the case between the parties.

Hence,

# ORDERED

that the application dated 30/03/2023, filed by both the parties are allowed in presence of both the parties of this proceeding along with their advocates. Accordingly the instant case is finally disposed off in terms of the memorandum of settlement dated 30/03/2023 and the said memorandum of settlement be made part of this award.

### Facts:

5) Sri Kashi Nath Ghosh, the concerned applicant was an employee of Development Research Communication and Service Centre at Kolkata office (hereinafter referred to as society). He was dismissed from his service.

He raised an industrial dispute before the Labour Department. As the matter was not settled, a reference has been made to the 5th Industrial Tribunal, West Bengal.

Both the parties appeared and have been contesting the matter. During hearing both the parties have settled the matter out of the Ld. Tribunal in the following terms and conditions.

# 6) TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF SETTLEMENT

- (a) It is agreed and accepted by Sri Kashi Nath ghosh that he has got no dispute with the Society in connection with any matter including the so-called issue referred to the Learned Tribunal vide order of Reference No. Labr./1021/(LC-IR)/IR/IIL-69/17 dt. 10.10.2017 (Ref. Case No. VIII 21 of 2017.
- (b) It is agreed and accepted by both the parties to the settlement that the entire dispute has been resolved out of the Learned Tribunal without creating any liability on the management of the Society in connection with Sri Kashinath Ghosh in any manner whatsoever.
- (c) It is agreed and accepted by Sri Kashinath Ghosh that he shall not pray for reinstatement / re-employment in the company in any manner what so ever including back wages before any Authority, Labour Court, Tribunal or any Court of Law.

- (d) It is agreed and accepted by both the parties to the instant settlement that Sri Kashinath Ghosh would be paid a sum of Rs.5,00,000/- (Rupees five lakhs) only by the Society in full and final settlement of his all dues and claims statutory or otherwise against the Society including any claim for reinstatement, reemployment or fresh employment along with back wages or any claim, statutory or otherwise inclusive of gratuity, in any manner whatsoever.
- (e) It is agreed that out of Rs.5,00,000/- (Rupees five lakh) only as aforesaid is being paid to him vide one Demand Draft being No. 029061 dated 27.03.2023 drawn on Axis Bank, Prince Anwar Shaw Road Branch, Kolkata 700 033 and in full and final settlement of his all dues and claims statutory or otherwise against the Society in connection with the case VIII 21 of 2017 Sri Kashinath Ghosh confirms that consequent upon payment of Rs.5,00,000/- (Rupees five lakhs) only he has got no claim/claims (statutory or otherwise) including gratuity in respect of the Society nor shall he himself or authorize anybody including any Union / Association to prefer any claim, statutory

or otherwise before any Authority, Labour Court, Tribunal or any Court of Law for preferring any claim for any amount against the society in any manner what so ever including claim for reinstatement, re-employment, fresh employment or back wages, interest or for any other amount whatsoever.

- (f) It is confirmed by Sri Kashinath Ghosh that in receiving the demand Draft for the said amount of Rs.5,00,000/- (Rupees five lakhs) only, total amount, he shall handover a receipt as a token of his acceptance of the said amount in full and final settlement of his all dues and claims against the society.
- (g) It is confirmed by Sri Kashinath Ghosh that upon payment of the settlement amount he is not interested at present with the Case No. VIII 21 of 2017 pending before the Learned Fifth Industrial Tribunal, Government of West Bengal, Kolkata in any manner whatsoever.
- (h) It is confirmed by Sri Kashinath Ghosh that he has accepted the said payment without any reservation and without being influenced by any one. He also confirms that consequent upon payment of Rs.5,00,000/- (Rupees five lakhs) only by the

Society he is not entitled to receive any amount from the Society over and above the said amount statutory or otherwise in connection with Case No. VIII 21 of 2017 before the Learned Fifth Industrial Tribunal, Government of West Bengal. This settles all the disputes and differences between the parties fully and finally.

- (i) It is agreed by and between the parties in the settlement that in view of the amicable settlement arrived at, the society shall not proceed against him in any manner whatsoever including the present reference.
- (ii) It has been further agreed by both the parties that they shall keep the terms and condition of this settlement confidential and not to disclose the same to any employees (whether present or former) of the society or any third parties from the date of execution of the foregoing settlement.
- (iii) It is confirmed by both the parties that they shall have no reservation in the event the present case, as mentioned in Clause 5 of the foregoing settlement is disposed of consequent upon signing of this settlement

07. This settlement settles all disputes and demands arising out of the Case No. VIII-21 of 2017 pending before the Learned Fifth Industrial Tribunal, Government of West Bengal fully and finally and connected proceedings including any order passed in connection thereof.
