Ltd., Apollo Towers, Plot No. 2, Sector 44, Gurgaon, Pin - 122002 and its workman Sri Samareswar Ghosh, 79/1, Raj Ballav Saha Lane, Howrah - 711101 regarding the issues being a matter specified in the second schedule of the Industrial Dispute act, 1947 (14of 1947);

AND WHEREAS the workman has filed an application directly under sub-section 2 of Section 2A of the Industrial Dispute act, 1947 (14of 1947) to the Seventh Industrial Tribunal Specified for this purpose under this Department Notification No. 101-IR dated 2.2.12:

Applicant Sri Samareswar Ghosh is absent without steps.

O.P. /Company is also absent without steps.

Today is fixed for passing no dispute order in view of order no. 20 dt. 18.03.2021.

Case record is taken up for passing order.

This case has been filed by the applicant/workman Samareswar Ghosh U/s 2A(2) of the Industrial Disputes Act, 1947 against his employer M/s. Apollo Fiege Integrated Logistics Pvt. Ltd. in connection with termination of his service with effect from 01.09.2016 illegally with a prayer to reinstate him in service with full back wages and other consequential benefits and also costs and interests thereto.

Perused the case record wherefrom it is seen that on 18.03.2021 the case was fixed for evidence of applicant's side, but applicant was found absent on that day on repeated calls and considering the previous conduct of the applicant, this Tribunal issued notice to the applicant directing him to show cause as to why a no dispute award shall not be passed in the instant case. It further appears from the record that in view order dt. 18.03.2021 show cause notice under registered post with A/D was sent to the applicant and from the A/D card, so received, it appears that the said show cause notice was duly served upon the applicant on 21.03.2022, but the applicant did not think it necessary to appear before this Tribunal till today



and also did not think it necessary to file show cause in view of order no. 20 dt. 18.03.2021. Therefore, it is clear that the applicant is not willing to proceed with his present case further.

In view of the aforesaid conduct of the applicant, this Tribunal holds that no industrial disputes exist in between the parties. So, I am inclined to pass a 'No Dispute' Award on the footings that Industrial Disputes under Rule 22 under West Bengal Industrial Dispute Rules, 1958 is no longer in existence.

Hence, it is

Ordered

That the case being No. 38 of 2018 U/s 2A(2) of the Industrial Disputes Act, 1947 be and the same is dismissed for non existence of any Industrial Dispute. This is to be treated as 'No Dispute Award'.
