Applicant Basukinath Dubey is absent without steps.

Today is fixed for passing No Dispute Award.

Case record is taken up for passing order.

This case has been filed by the applicant/workman Basukinath Dubey U/s 2A(2) of the Industrial Disputes Act, 1947 against his employers M1. Bagree Estates Pvt. Ltd, 2. Smt. Radha Bagree, 3. Sri Varun Raj Bagree, 4. The Executive Officer, 7, Lyons Range, 2nd Floor, Kolkata – 700 001 in connection with termination of his service illegally with a prayer to reinstate him in service with full back wages and other consequential benefits.

Perused the case record wherefrom it is seen that on 07.10.2021 case was fixed for ex parte argument, but the applicant was found absent on that day on repeated calls and considering the conduct of the applicant, this Tribunal issued notice to the applicant directing him to submit show cause on 17.12.2021 as to why no dispute award shall not be passed in the instant case. It further appears from the record that in view order dt. 07.10.2021 show cause notice under registered post with A/D was sent to the applicant and from the A/D card, so received, it appears that the said show cause notice was duly served upon the applicant on 12.11.2021, but the applicant did not think it necessary to appear before this Tribunal even also on the last date i.e. on 08.04.2022 and also did not think it necessary to file show cause in view of order no. 51 dt. 07.10.2021 till today. Therefore, it is clear that the applicant is not willing to proceed with his present case further.



In view of the aforesaid conduct of the applicant, this Tribunal holds that no industrial dispute exists in between the parties. So, I am inclined to pass a 'No Dispute' Award on the footings that Industrial Disputes under Rule 22 under West Bengal Industrial Dispute Rules, 1958 is no longer in existence.

Hence, it is

Ordered

that the case being No. 15 of 2018 U/s 2A(2) of the Industrial Disputes Act, 1947 be and the same is dismissed for non existence of any Industrial Dispute. This is to be treated as 'No Dispute Award '.
