Today is fixed for passing necessary order. The employee and the employer have not taken any steps today. Today also none appeared on repeated calls.

On careful perusal of the record it is found that the workman, Sri Monoj Sherma, filed this case directly to this Tribunal for setting aside the order of dismissal. Accordingly, the case was started and notices were issued in Form No.D2 fixing 03/07/2003 for SR, appearance and for further order. It is found that notices were served and both the parties appeared. Since last few dates no step has been taken by the employee and the employer. Therefore, it is clear that the petitioner has no interest in the further proceeding of this case and there is also no reasonable ground to keep this case pending any more.

Under such circumstances, I have no other alternative but to hold that the Industrial Disputes raised in between the parties to this case is no longer in existence and accordingly the case is to be disposed of as per provision of Rule-22 of the West Bengal Industrial Disputes Rules, 1958. Hence it is

ORDERED

That this Industrial Dispute between the parties to this case is no longer in existence and accordingly no award is passed. The case is disposed of accordingly.
