Sri Anil Kumar Dutta, workman, represented by West Bengal Cha Sramik Union bearing, Regd. No.2233, having its office at Kerani Para, P.O. & Dist. Jalpaiguri.

Employer files hazira through Ld. Advocate. The workman takes no step. None appears on calls on behalf of both sides. It is settled legal position that simply filing hazira through Ld. Advocate cannot be treated an appearance if the Ld. Advocate does not appear on call. The Ld. Advocate for the employer did not appear on repeated calls. In such situation it is clear that both parties are not at all interested in proceeding with this case. In such situation it is a fit case for disposing of by passing an order of No Dispute Award.

On careful perusal of the record it is found that a copy of Order No.1272-I.R./IR/9L-06/99 dated 07/11/2007 of the Govt. of West Bengal, Labour Department, I. R. Branch, Writers' Buildings, Kolkata-700001, was received on 27.11.2007. Accordingly, the case was started and notices were issued in Form No. D2 fixing 11/01/2008 for SR, appearance and for further order. It is found that notices were served and both the parties appeared. Since last few dates and no step has been taken by the employee and employer. Therefore, it is clear that the petitioner has no interest in the further proceeding of this case and there is also no reasonable ground to keep this case pending any more.

Under such circumstances, I have no other alternative but to hold that the Industrial Disputes raised in between the parties to this case is no longer in existence and accordingly the case is to be disposed of as per provision of Rule-22 of the West Bengal Industrial Disputes Rules, 1958. Hence it is

ORDERED

Sixth Indistrial Tribunal That this Industrial Dispute between the parties to this case is no longer in existence and accordingly no award is passed. The case is disposed of accordingly.
