Today is fixed for further evidence of employer side. The employee and the employer have not taken any steps today. None appeared on repeated calls.

On careful perusal of the record it is found that a copy of Order No. 797-I.R./IR/11L-7/97 dated 03/05/1999 of the Govt. of West Bengal, Labour Department, I. R. Branch, Writers' Buildings, Kolkata-700001, was received on 13.05.1999. Accordingly, the case was started and notices were issued in Form No. D2 fixing 31/05/1999 for SR, appearance and for further order. It is found that notices were served and both the parties appeared. Since last few dates and no step has been taken by the employee and employer. Therefore, it is clear that the petitioner has no interest in the further proceeding of this case and there is also no reasonable ground to keep this case pending any more.

Under such circumstances, I have no other alternative but to hold that the Industrial Disputes raised in between the parties to this case is no longer in existence and accordingly the case is to be disposed of as per provision of Rule-22 of the West Bengal Industrial Disputes Rules, 1958.
