AWARD

This industrial dispute between M/s. New Friends Enterprise (Tripathy Complex, Debhog, City Center, Haldia) under the Management of M/s. Renuka Sugar Ltd. Vill & P.O. Debhog, City Center, Dist. Purba Medinipur and Sri Santu Jana, Vill. Mahatma Gandhi Nagar, P.O. – Hatiberia, P.S.- Haldia, Purba Medinipur, Pin – 721 657 has been referred by the Govt. of West Bengal, Labour Department vide Order No. 643-IR/IR/11L-64/13, dated 21.05.2014, to this Tribunal for adjudication of the following issues: -

ISSUES(S)

- 1. Whether the refusal of employment of Sri Santu Jana by M/s. New Friends Enterprise, under the Management of M/s. Renuka Sugar Ltd. w.e.f 11.12.2011 was justified?
- 2. What relief, if any, he is entitled to?

Record reveals that the present reference bearing G.O. No. 643-IR/IR/11L-64/13, dated 21.05.2014 under Sec. 10 read with Sub-section 2A of the Industrial Disputes Act, 1947 for adjudication has been registered on 24.06.2014 vide Order No. 1 and notice upon the parties were duly served.

On close scrutiny of the earlier orders and materials on record I find that on 30.06.2017 the applicant filed an application for dismissel of the case for non-prosecution on the grounds that the matter has been settled between the parties out of Court and he has settled the case voluntarily out of his free will and on his own accord. No coercion or any undue influence has ever been made upon him for settling the case.

This case is pending since 2014 in view of the application of the applicant and his deposition on oath on 30.06.2017, I find no tangible groun? to drag this case any further.

Considering the above and the attending circumstances of the instant adjudication I am inclined to pass a 'No Dispute Award' in the instant adjudication.

Therefore, I think that it is a fit case to pass a 'No Dispute Award' under Rule 22 of Industrial Disputes Rules, 1958, the industrial dispute by and between the parties being treated as non-existent.

Accordingly 'No Dispute Award' under Rule 22 of West Bengal Industrial Disputes Rules, 1958 is passed.
