AWARD

Today is posted for filing show cause by O.P. No.1 and hearing of petition dated 12.02.2018 filed by the applicant. Ld. advocates for both the O.Ps as well as the applicant are present. One petition is filed by the applicant stating that the matter has been amicably settled out of court and the applicant shall not proceed with this case.

The applicant is examined as Court Witness No.1.

This case was filed by the applicant, Tapan Kr. Pyne against the management of Securitrans India Pvt. Ltd. being the Respondent No.1 and the Management of HDFC Bank Ltd. being the Respondent No.2 U/s. 10 of the Industrial Disputes Act. The contention of the case, is that the petitioner was a Contract Labourer under the Respondent No.1 and he was under the service of Respondent No.2. It is alleged that the Respondent No.2, terminated his service without the knowledge of Respondent No.1 illegally. He prayed for reinstatement of service and back wages.

The matter has been amicably settled in between the parties. The applicant in his deposition has stated that he has no grudge at present against any of the

Respondents and as per the settlement he has received a cheque to the tune of Rs. 1,00,000/- (Rupees One Lac)only bearing No. 004573 dated 03.05.2018 drawn on ICICI Bank, Lucknow Branch. The applicant received the cheque in open court. While the matter has been amicably settled, this court shall not stand as bar in between the parties.

Hence, it is,

<u>Ordered</u>

that the instant case filed U/s. 10 of the Industrial Disputes Act. 1947 be and the same is dismissed for non-prosecution and no industrial dispute exits in the instant case for the present.

This is the "No-Dispute" Award passed by this court and accordingly the instant case is disposed of finally.
