AWARD

The instant case arose out of an application u/s 10(1B)(d) of the Industrial Dispute Act, 1947 as amended filed by the workman Sri Ratan Mullick against his employer M/s. Visual Securas Ltd., Block-AD-239, Sector-1, Bidhan Naghar, Kolkata- 700 064 in connection with the termination of his service by the employer and seeking an order/award that the said order of termination is unjustified and also prayed for reinstatement in service with full back wages and consequential relief.

On receipt of such application notice was issued to the opposite party asking the opposite party to file written statement. The opposite party (company) filed written statement and thereafter on the basis of the pleadings of the parties issues were framed.

Thereafter the recording of evidence has been commenced and the parties laid evidences both oral and documentary and the case was posted for hearing of argument. At that juncture the parties expressed their desire to make a settlement of the dispute amicably.

Today 23.03.2018 the parties filed a joint petition together with Memorandum of Settlement praying for passing an award in terms of such Memorandum of Settlement.

Statements of the workman Sri Ratan Mullick is recorded on point of settlement in presence of the union representative moving the matter of the workman. Similarly, the statement of Sri Sumanta Banerjee, H.R. Manager of the company is recorded on the point of settlement. Both the workman and the company representative has stated that the dispute involved in the present proceedings has amicably been settled. The workman has stated that he entered into such settlement voluntarily with the company and nobody induced him or put any undue influence on him to enter into such settlement. He has also stated that he signed the joint petition and the Memorandum of Settlement after having understood the contents of the same which was read over and explained to him in Bengali. The witness for the company has also deposed in the same tune. He has stated that the company issued two separate account payee cheques dated 23.3.2018 amounting to rupees 1 lakh each drawn on HDFC Bank, Salt Lake City Branch. Kolkata to

full and final settlement of the dispute. The workman has also stated that he has received those 2 cheques as paid to him by the company amounting Rs. 1 Lakh each and the said amount of 2 lakhs includes and cover all his legal dues including gratuity, leave salary and retirement benefit. It is agreed by the parties as mentioned in the Memorandum of Settlement and has stated by them on oath that the company will cooperate with the workman in the matter of recovery of Provident Fund amount before the appropriate authority. The Xerox copy two such cheques are also filed. Both the workman and the company representative have stated that award may be passed in terms of such settlement.

Decision with Reasons

Upon careful perusal of the materials on record and the Memorandum of Settlement filed by the parties and also statements of the workman and the representative of the company recorded on oath today, I find that parties have amicably settled the dispute in terms of such Memorandum of Settlement filed before this Tribunal today. The terms of the settlement appear to be legal and valid. It further appears that such settlement has been filed by the parties voluntarily. That being so I find no legal impediment to dispose of the instant proceedings in terms of such Memorandum of Settlement as jointly filed by the parties. Accordingly, I hold that an award should be passed as prayed for the parties in terms of said Memorandum of Settlement filed today. Hence, it is

ORDERED

that the award be passed in terms of the Memorandum of Settlement dated 23.03.2018 dully signed by the parties and the said Memorandum of Settlement do form part of the award along with annexure, if any. The instant case is thus disposed of in terms of Memorandum of Settlement jointly filed by the parties.

This is my <u>AWARD</u>.


