## AWARD

This industrial dispute between M/s. New Friends Enterprise (Tripathy Complex, Debhog, City Center, Haldia) under the Management of M/S Renuka Sugar Ltd. Vill & P.O. Debhog, City Center, Dist. Purba Medinipur and Sri Dibyendu Shekhar Bag, Vill. Mahatm Gandhi Nagar, P.O. Hatiberia, P.S. Haldia, Purba Medinipur, Pin 721657 has been referred by the Govt. of West Bengal, Labour Department vide G.O. No. 642-IR/IR/11L-64/13 dated 21.05.2014 to this Tribunal for adjudication of the following issues: -

## ISSUES(S)

- Whether the refusal of employment of Sri Dibyendu Shekhar Bag by M/S
  New Friends Enterprise, under the Management of M/S Renuka Sugar
  Ltd. w.e.f. 11.12.2011was justified?
- 2. What relief, in any, he is entitled to?

Today is fixed for passing of "No dispute Award".

The O.P. No.2 M/S Renuka Sugar Ltd.is present today but the applicant, Dibyendu Shekhar Bag is absent. On repeated calls none appears on behalf of the applicant and /or O.P.No.1.

Record reveals that the applicant absented himself from 06.01.2020. Vide order No. 77 dated 06.02.2020 notice to show-cause was issued against the applicant, vide this Office memo.no. 142 dated 07.02.2020 as to why 'No Dispute Award' shall

not be passed against him. A/D reveals that the notice has been duly served, but in spite of notice no step taken on behalf of the applicant.

Considering the reluctant attitude of the applicant to proceed with the instant adjudication, I am persuaded to safely presume that he is no more interested to proceed with this adjudication and further adjournment will be nothing but abuse of Tribunal's process and time.


Such being the conduct on the part of the applicant coupled with the fact, I think that in order to protect the judicial sanctity no further indulgence should be given to this applicant because justice is not monopoly to him.

Therefore, I am of the view that it is a fit case to pass a 'No Dispute Award' under Rule 22 of Industrial Disputes Rules, 1958, the industrial dispute by and between the parties being treated as non-existent.
