Today is fixed for showing cause by the workman. The employee and the employer have not taken any steps today. None appeared on repeated calls.

On careful perusal of the record it is found that a copy of Order No. 408-I.R. dated 02/05/2005 of the Govt. of West Bengal, Labour Department, I. R. Branch, Writers' Buildings, Kolkata-700001, was received on 01.06.2005. Accordingly, the case was started and notices were issued in Form No. D2 fixing 16/03/2006 for SR, appearance and for further order. It is found that notices were served and both the parties appeared. Since last few dates and no step has been taken by the employee and employer. Therefore, it is clear that the petitioner has no interest in the further proceeding of this case and there is also no reasonable ground to keep this case pending any more.
