At this stage, applicant files a verified petition praying for permission to withdraw the instant case.

The petition for withdrawal is taken up for hearing.

Heard Ld. Advocate for the applicant as well as applicant Bhaskar Sen in person, who submits that he does not want to proceed with the instant case further and prays for permission to withdraw the instant case against the O.P./Company. He further submits that he has voluntarily filed the present withdrawal petition and also voluntarily puts his signature thereon.

Perused the present petition for withdrawal along with case record. This is a case U/S 10(1b)(d) of Industrial Disputes Act, 1947, filed by the applicant Bhaskar Sen against O.P./M/s. Bengal Waterproof Limited in connection with termination of his service. Now, applicant does not want to proceed with the instant case and prays for permission to withdraw the instant case. Considered. Since the applicant does not want to proceed with the instant case, I think that his prayer for withdrawal the instant case should be allowed.

Hence, it is,

## ORDERED

that the petition for withdrawal dated 06.09.2021 is allowed without costs.

Applicant namely, Sri Bhaskar Sen is permitted to withdraw the instant Case No. 06 of 2018 under Section 10(1B)(d) of the Industrial Disputes Act, 1947, as amended .
