On careful perusal of the record it is found that the workman Sri Karen Barman filed this case directly to this Tribunal for setting aside the order of dismissal. Accordingly, the case was started and notices were issued in Form No.D2 fixing 13/08/2007 for SR, appearance and for further order. It is found that notices were served and both the parties appeared. Since last few dates no step has been taken by the employee and the employer. Therefore, it is clear that the petitioner has no interest in the further proceeding of this case and there is also no reasonable ground to keep this case pending any more.


