WHEREAS an industrial dispute existed between M/s. W.W.A Cossipur English School, 59, Seven Tanks Estate, 4, Dum Dum Road, Kolkata - 700002 and their workman Sri Paritosh Saha, Ram Krishna Pally, Bandipur, P.O. Rahara, Distt. - North 24-Parganas regarding the issue, being a matter specified in the second schedule to the Industrial Dispute Act, 1947 (14 of 1947);

AND WHEREAS the workmen has filled an application under section 10(2A) of the Industrial Dispute Act, 1947 (14 of 1947) to the Judge, Second Industrial Tribunal, Kolkata specified for this purpose under this Deptt.'s Notification No. 1085-IR/12L-9/95 dated 25.07.1997.

AND WHEREAS, Second Industrial Tribunal, Kolkata heard the parties under section 10(2A) of the I.D. Act, 1947 (14 of 1947).

AND WHEREAS Second Industrial Tribunal, Kolkata has submitted to the State Government its Award under section 10(2A) of the I.D. Act, 1947 (14 of 1947) on the said Industrial Dispute.

Case No. VIII-48 of 2009

Under Section 10(2A) of The Industrial Disputes Act, 1947

Order No. 147 dt. 28.04.2022

The petitioner is absent and takes no step and none appears for the petitioner.

The Ld. Lawyer for the O.P. company is present. Today is fixed for argument but the Ld. Lawyer for the petitioner is absent.

On perusing the record, I find that the case is pending for argument on merit for many days but sometimes both parties were absent on the dates fixed and sometimes one of the parties appeared but the argument could not be heard due to absence of the other side and today also the argument could not be heard as the petitioner is absent and none appeared for the petitioner.

As the petitioner did not attend today to submit argument, no argument is heard from the Ld. lawyer for the Opposite Party and on perusing the record I hold that the petitioner is unwilling to proceed with this case further.

Hence, the case is taken up for passing Award.

The case was filed by the petitioner, Smt. Sandhya Saha, Ram Krishna Pally, Bandipur, P.O. Rahara, Distt.-North 24-Parganas against the Opposite Party namely, M/s. W.W.A. Cossipur English School, 59, Seven Tanks Estate, 4, Dum Dum Road, Kolkata-700 002 and record shows that during pendency of this case the petitioner, Sandhya Saha died and her legal heir, Paritosh Saha was impleaded as the petitioner in place of deceased Sandhya Saha.

This is a case under Section 10(2A) of The Industrial Disputes Act, 1947.

As the petitioner is unwilling to proceed with this case, the case is dismissed for non-prosecution against the Opposite Party.

Hence, it is

**ORDERED**

that the Case No. VIII-48 of 2009 under Section 10(2A) of The Industrial Disputes Act, 1947 is dismissed for non-prosecution against the O.P. company.

Let this judgement and order be treated as an Award.
