Today is fixed for passing no dispute award in view of order no. 13 dt.

16.03.2022.

This case has been initiated on the strength of an order of reference bearing G.O. No. Labr./1467/(LC-IR)/22015(13)/1/2020 dated 06.10.2020, issued by the Labour Department, Govt. of West Bengal referring an Industrial Dispute between M/s. Adi Amrita Bastralaya and its workman Sri Susanta Das U/s 10 read with Sub-Section 2A of the Industrial Disputes Act, 1947 for adjudication of two issues viz. 1) Whether the termination of service of Sri Susanta Das by way of retrench with effect from 24.05.2018 by the management of M/s Adi Amrita Bastralaya is justified ? 2) What relief, if any, the workman is entitled to?

Perused the case record wherefrom it is seen that on 16.03.2022 this case was fixed for filing list of documents along with documents by the parties, but applicant was found absent on that day without steps. Considering such conduct of the applicant, this Tribunal issued notice under registered post with A/D, directing the applicant to appear and to file show cause as to why no dispute award shall not be passed against him. Show cause notice, sent under registered post with A/D was returned unserved. This Tribunal found that the applicant stopped taking steps on and from 31.12.2021 and so, need not send show cause notice again to the applicant. Applicant did not think it necessary to

appear before this Tribunal or to file show cause petition till today. Therefore, it can safely be said that the applicant is not willing to proceed with his present case further.

In view of the aforesaid conduct of the applicant, this Tribunal holds that no industrial disputes exist in between the parties. So, I am inclined to pass a 'No Dispute' Award on the footings that Industrial Disputes under Rule 22 under West Bengal Industrial Dispute Rules, 1958 is no longer in existence.

Hence, it is

Ordered

That the case being No. 11 of 2010 U/s 10 (2A) of the Industrial Disputes Act, 1947 be and the same is dismissed for non existence of any Industrial Dispute. This is to be treated as 'No Dispute Award'.
