AWARD

An industrial dispute between the Employer i.e. Employers i.e. M/S. C. Ringer & Company, 23, Lalbazar Street, Kolkata – 700 001 and their Workman represented by C. Ringer & Company Employees' Union (Regd. No. 8704) Situated at 12A, Netaji Subhash Road, Kolkata – 700 001, referred to this Tribunal Vide G. O. No. 954-IR/IR/11L-06/09(Pt.) dated 17/09/2015 and Notification No. 803-IR/IR/3A-2/57, dated 11/03/1957, to this Tribunal for adjudication on the following issues:-

ISSUE(S)

- 1. Whether the act of refusal of employment to Sri Ajoy Malakar and 5 (five) other workmen as mentioned in the Annexure in the disguise of transfer on the part of the management of M/s. C. Ringer & Co. is justified?
- 2. If not, what relief are they entitled to?

The case record is taken up for passing order.

On perusal the case record it appears that both the parties were show caused by this Tribunal since 29/12/2021 but surprisingly none of the parties appears before this Tribunal till last date i.e. on 15/06/2022. It is further reveals from the case record that inspite of several attempts took by this Tribunal to send show cause notices by registered post with A/D but none of the parties accepted those show cause notice reasons known best to them. None appears before this Tribunal since 27/12/2021.

Considering the above facts and circumstances, it is clear that both the parties i.e. the petitioner C. Ringer & Co. Employees' Union and OP M/s. C. Ringer & Company and the added party No. 2) Sri Sailendra Nath Mukherjee, Partner of M/s. C. Ringer & Co., are not insisted to proceed with the hearing of this case. Therefore this Tribunal has no hesitation to hold that there is no dispute exists at present between the parties and as such the case is liable to be disposed off in view of Rule 22 of the West Bengal Industrial Dispute Rule, 1958.

Hence,

ORDERED

that Industrial Dispute under reference Vide G. O. No. 954-IR/IR/11L-06/09(Pt.) dated 17/09/2015 and Notification No. 803-IR/IR/3A-2/57, dated 11/03/1957, is no longer inexistence and accordingly the case is disposed off and this order is to be treated as No Dispute Award between the parties.
