Perused the case record wherefrom it appears that since 18.08.2021 the applicant is absent. As a result, a notice was issued on 17.05.2022 against the applicant directing him to file show cause on 04.07.2022 as to why no dispute award shall not be passed in the instant case. Till 10.08.2023 the applicant was absent on repeated calls. Thereafter, vide order no. 64 dated 10.08.2023 a fresh notice was sent to the applicant directing him to file show cause as to why no dispute award shall not be passed in the instant case. Inspite of service of notice the applicant did not bother to appear before this Tribunal till date. The applicant was absent on repeated calls on 21.09.2023 and no show cause was also filed from the side of the applicant till date.

Therefore, it is clear that the applicant is not willing and bothered to proceed with his present case further.

In view of the aforesaid conduct of the applicant, this Tribunal holds that no industrial disputes exist in between the parties. So, I am inclined to pass a 'No Dispute' Award on the footings that Industrial Disputes under Rule 22 under West Bengal Industrial Dispute Rules, 1958 is no longer in existence.

Hence, it is

Ordered

that the case being No. 51 of 2015 u/S 2A(2) of the Industrial Disputes Act, 1947 be and the same is dismissed for non existence of any Industrial Dispute. This is to be treated as 'No Dispute Award '.
