Both the parties are absent without steps.

Judge 1 Pribution Today is fixed for passing no dispute award in view of order no. 63 dt. 29.02.2024.

Case record is taken up for passing award.

This case has been filed by the applicant/workman Sri Munshi Yadav under Section 2A(2) of the Industrial Disputes Act, 1947 against his employer M/s. Sinthee Gas Services in connection with termination of his service with effect from 17.03.2015 illegally with a prayer to reinstate him in service with full back wages and other consequential benefits.

Perused the case record wherefrom it appears that order was passed on 24.03.2023 fixing 28.04.2023 for hearing of the petition dated 24.03.2023 filed by the Ld. Advocate for the O.P. and W/O, if any, in the meantime. On 22.11.2023 the applicant did not appear, but the Ld. Advocate for the applicant was present and submitted that he has no instruction and prayed to issue notice. On that day, a notice was issued to the applicant directing him to appear on 29.12.2023 and file reply to show cause as to why no dispute award shall be passed in the instant case. Thereafter, on 29.12.2023 it



appeared from the postal track report that the notice sent to the applicant has been delivered with postal remark 'Item Delivered (Addressee)'. On that date the applicant was absent on repeated calls, but an opportunity was given by this Tribunal to the applicant for appearance and filing reply to show cause on the next date i.e. on 29.02.2024. But on the said date none appeared for the applicant on repeated calls and the applicant did not think it necessary to appear before this Tribunal and to file reply to show cause in view of order no. 63 dated 29.02.2024. Therefore, it is clear that the applicant is not willing to proceed with his present case further.

In view of the aforesaid conduct of the applicant, this Tribunal holds that no industrial disputes exist in between the parties. So, I am inclined to pass a 'No Dispute' Award on the footings that Industrial Disputes under Rule 22 under West Bengal Industrial Dispute Rules, 1958 is no longer in existence.

Hence, it is

Ordered

that the case being No. 53 of 2015 U/s 2A(2) of the Industrial Disputes Act, 1947 be and the same is dismissed for non existence of any Industrial Dispute. This is to be treated as 'No Dispute Award'.
