Both the parties are absent without steps.

Today is fixed for passing no dispute award.

Accordingly, the case is taken up for passing no dispute award in view of Order No. 30 dated 15.02.2024.

The instant case is a reference case Under Section 10 of the Industrial Disputes Act, 1947.

In this case written statement has been filed by the pplicant/workman Shri Sushil Tiwari in connection with termination of his service illegally with a prayer to reinstate him in service with full back wages and other consequential benefits and also costs and interests thereto.

Perused the case record wherefrom it appears that on 03.12.2021 the case was fixed for appearance of applicant but applicant was absent on that day on repeated calls and this Tribunal on the said date i.e. on 03.12.2021 passed an order for issuing notice to the applicant directing him to appear on the next date i.e. on 16.02.2023. As the applicant did not appear on 16.02.2023 this Tribunal again issued fresh notice to the applicant and directed him to appear and file reply to show cause on 27.03.2023 as to why a no dispute award shall not be passed in the instant case. Thereafter, again

on 03.07.2023 a fresh notice was issued to the applicant directing him to appear and reply to show cause on 07.09,2023 as to why no dispute award shall not be passed in the instant case. Thereafter, on 31.01.2024 this Tribunal observed that the notice sent to the applicant has been delivered with postal remark "Item Delivered (Addressee)", but on that day also the applicant was absent on repeated calls and no reply to show cause was filed from his side.

It appears from the case record that the applicant did not bother to appear before this Tribunal till date and also did not think it necessary to file reply to show cause. Therefore, it is clear that the applicant is not willing to proceed with his present case further.

In view of the aforesaid conduct of the applicant, this Tribunal holds that no industrial disputes exist in between the parties. So, I am inclined to pass a 'No Dispute' Award on the footings that Industrial Disputes under Rule 22 under West Bengal Industrial Dispute Rules, 1958 is no longer in existence.

Hence, it is

Ordered

that the case being No. 06 of 2020 U/s 10 of the Industrial Disputes Act, 1947 be and the same is dismissed for non existence of any Industrial Dispute. This is to be treated as 'No Dispute Award'.
