This case has been filed by the applicant/workman Ritesh Das under Section 2A(2) of the Industrial Disputes Act, 1947 against his employer M/s Emcure Pharmaceuticals Limited in connection with termination of service of the applicant illegally with a prayer to reinstate him in service with full back wages and other consequential benefits.

Perused the case record wherefrom it appears that since 24.08.2023 the applicant is absent. As a result, a notice was issued upon him directing to file show cause on 29.11.2023 as to why no dispute award shall not be passed in the instant case. Since thereafter no show cause has been filed by the applicant. Thereafter, on 29.11.2023 the instant case was fixed for passing no dispute award as the applicant was absent on repeated calls. Therefore, it is clear that the applicant is not willing to proceed with his present case further.
