This Award is delivered on Tuesday, the 25th Day of March, 2025.

AWARD

Today is fixed for passing order in respect of Memorandum of Settlement on compromise dated 17.03.2025, filed jointly by both the parties.

The case record is taken up for passing order.

Perused the Memorandum of Settlement (Exbt. B) dated 17.03.2025, joint petition filed by the parties under Section 10(1B)(d) of the Industrial Disputes Act, 1947 (as amended) as well as evidence of the applicant Sri Amarjit Singh (P.W.1) and Mr. Dipankar Roy, Assistant General Manager-HRM of M/s Khadim India Ltd., authorized representative of the O.P./Company namely M/s Khadim India Ltd., (O.P.W.1), the Certified true copy of Board Resolution (Exbt.A) and the receipt issued by the applicant (Exbt.C), so adduced in support of said Memorandum of Settlement(Exbt.B).

It appears from the evidence of P.W.1 and O.P.W.1 that the matter in dispute has already been settled in between the parties in terms of Memorandum of Settlement dated 17.03.2025 (Exbt. B) . I further find from the said joint petition , Memorandum of Settlement as well as from the evidence of both the parties that the Company has handed over an account

payee cheque being No. 746739 dated 11.03.2025 of Rs. 76,892/- (Seventy six thousand eight hundred ninety two) only drawn on Indian Overseas Bank, Kolkata and also cheque being No. 968801 dated 11.03.2025 of Rs. 2,73,108/- (Two lakh seventy three thousand one hundred eight) only drawn on SBI, Jeevan Deep Building, 1, Middleton Street, Kolkata—to the applicant as full and final settlement amount, and the applicant has issued a receipt of the same, marked as Exbt. C and also that the applicant (P.W.1) has no grievance against the O.P./Company at present. A xerox copy of the said two account payee Cheques of full and final settlement amount has been marked as Exbt.1 & 1/1. An original receipt of the same—has been filed to that effect, marked as Exbt.C. Considered.

The Memorandum of Settlement dated 17.03.2025 and the joint petition dated 17.03.2025 filed by both the parties has duly been signed by the applicant, Sri Amarjit Singh (P.W.1) and Mr. Dipankar Roy (O.P.W.1) representing the O.P./Company voluntarily. Since the matter has already been settled between the parties to the proceedings, I am of the view that this Tribunal should not stand in the way of their settlement/compromise, which appears to be legal and valid, and so, this Tribunal finds no impediment in allowing such prayer made jointly by the parties voluntarily.

Hence, it is

Ordered

that the settlement between the parties is allowed and accordingly, the proceedings of the instant case being No. 04/2022 under Section 10(1B)(d) of the Industrial Disputes Act, 1947, as amended, be and the same is disposed of in terms of the Memorandum of Settlement dated 17.03.2025. The Memorandum of Settlement dated 17.03.2025 is made part of the Award.

This is my Award.
