AWARD

This Award is delivered on Tuesday, the 30th Day of April, 2025.

Today is fixed for passing order in respect of Memorandum of Settlement on compromise dated 24.04.2025, filed jointly by both the parties.

The case record is taken up for passing order.

At the very outset, the wife of the applicant Mrs. Mina Debi Singh (P.W.1) apprised today that the cheque given by the O.P. is cleared and the settlement amount of the cheque has been credited in the account of the applicant/workman Bhagaban Singh.

Perused the Memorandum of Settlement (Exbt. A) dated 24.04.2025, joint petition filed by the parties under Section 10(1B)(d) of the Industrial Disputes Act, 1947 (as amended) as well as evidence of the wife of the applicant Mina Debi Singh (P.W.1) who deposed on behalf of the applicant on the basis of special power of attorney, (Exbt. 1) and Ketan Shanghavi, one of the partners of the O.P./Company namely M/s Western Commercial Corporation, (O.P.W.1), so adduced in support of said Memorandum of Settlement (Exbt.A).

It appears from the evidence of P.W.1 and O.P.W.1 that the matter in dispute has already been settled in between the parties in terms of Memorandum of Settlement dated 24.04.2025 (Exbt. B). I further find from the said joint petition, Memorandum of Settlement as well as from the evidence of both parties that the Company has handed over an account payee cheque being No. 001943 dated 23.04.2025 for Rs 1,00,000/- (One lakh) only drawn on HDFC Bank, 31 Chowringhee Road, Park Street, Kolkata – 700 016 in the name the

applicant Bhagaban Singh as full and final settlement amount as per Memorandum of Settlement. The xerox copy of the said cheque, marked as Exbt. 2. The receipt of the cheque issued by the wife of the applicant is marked as Exbt. B. Considered.

The Memorandum of Settlement dated 24.04.2025 and the joint petition dated 24.04.2025 filed by both the parties has duly been signed by the applicant, Mina Debi Singh (P.W.1) and Ketan Sanghavi (O.P.W.1) representing the O.P. as partner of the Company voluntarily. Since the matter has already been settled between the parties to the proceedings, I am of the view that this Tribunal should not stand in the way of their such settlement/compromise, which appears to be legal and valid, and so, this Tribunal finds no impediment in allowing such prayer made jointly by the parties voluntarily.

Hence, it is

Ordered

that the settlement between the parties is allowed and accordingly, the proceedings of the instant case being No. 50/2015 under Section 10(1B)(d) of the Industrial Disputes Act, 1947, as amended, be and the same is disposed of in terms of the Memorandum of Settlement dated 24.04.2025. The Memorandum of Settlement dated 24.04.2025 is made part of the Award.

This is my Award.
