A W A R D

Today is fixed for passing order in respect of Memorandum of Settlement on compromise dated 18.12.2024, filed jointly by both the parties.

The case record is taken up for passing order.

Perused the Memorandum of Settlement (Exbt. A) dated 18.12.2024, joint petition filed by the parties and order of reference of Labour Department, Govt. of West Bengal under Section 10 of the Industrial Disputes Act, 1947 (as amended) as well as evidence of the applicant Sri Dilip Kumar Rai (P.W.1) and Sri Nimish Saraf, C.E.O of M/s. Alliance Commercial Transport (O.P.W.1), so adduced in support of said Memorandum of Settlement (Exbt. A).

It appears from the evidence of P.W.1 and O.P.W.1 that the matter in dispute has already been settled in between the parties in terms of Memorandum of Settlement dated 18.12.2024 (Exbt. A) . I further find from the said joint petition , Memorandum of Settlement as well as from the evidence of both parties that the Company has handed over a demand draft being No. 520205 dated 17.12.2024 of Rs. 1,50,000/- (One lakh fifty thousand) only drawn on ICICI Bank Limited to the applicant as full and final settlement amount and the applicant has issued a receipt of the same, marked as Exbt. 2

and also that the applicant (P.W.1) has no grievance against the O.P./Company at present. A xerox copy of the said Demand Draft of full and final settled amount has been marked as Exbt. 1. A xerox copy of money receipt has been filed to that effect, marked as Exbt.2. Considered.

The Memorandum of Settlement dated 18.12.2024 and the joint petition dated 18.12.2024 filed by both the parties has duly been signed by the applicant, Sri Dilip Kumar Rai (P.W.1) and Sri Nimish Saraf (O.P.W.1), CEO of the O.P./Company voluntarily. Since the matter has already been settled between the parties to the proceedings, I am of the view that this Tribunal should not stand in the way of their such settlement/compromise, which appears to be legal and valid, and so, this Tribunal finds no impediment in allowing such prayer made jointly by the parties voluntarily.

Hence, it is

Ordered

that the settlement between the parties is allowed and accordingly, the proceedings under Section 10 of the Industrial Disputes Act, 1947, as amended, be and the same is disposed of in terms of the Memorandum of Settlement dated 18.12.2024. The Memorandum of Settlement dated 18.12.2024 is made part of the Award.
