Today is fixed for passing award in respect of Memorandum of Settlement on compromise dated 21.06.2024, filed by both the parties.

The case record is taken up for passing award.

Perused the Memorandum of Settlement (Exbt. B) dated 21.06.2024 and petition Under Section 2A(2) of the Industrial Disputes Act, 1947 (as amended) as well as evidence of the applicant Mrs. Champa Devi (P.W.1) and Mr. Shantanu Saha, O.P.W.1 (authorized representative of the O.P./Company), (Authority letter (Exbt. A) so adduced in support of said Memorandum of Settlement (Exbt. B).

It appears from the evidences of P.W.1 and O.P.W.1 that the matter in dispute has already been settled in between the parties in terms of Memorandum of Settlement dated 21.06.2024 (Exbt. B), I further find from the said Memorandum of Settlement as well as from the evidence of both the parties that the Company has handed over a Cheque being No. 833749 dated 10.06.2024 of Rs. 1,40,000/- (One lakh forty thousand only) drawn on Yes Bank Ltd., Stephen House, 56A, Hemanta Basu Sarani, Kolkata – 700 001 to the applicants as full and final settlement amount (Copy of Cheque, marked as Exbt. 2). The applicants No. 2 to 6 by filing affidavit dted 05.06.2024 (Exbt.1) stated that they have no objection if a cheque of full and

final settlement amount is handed over to Mrs. Champa Devi (P.W.1) and accordingly, the said cheque was handed over by the O.P. to the applicant (P.W.1) as full and final settled amount and the Ld. Advocate for the O.P. apprised this Tribunal that the amount of the said cheque in respect of full and final settlement has already been credited to the Bank Account of the applicant (P.W.1). It also appears from the evidence of P.W.1 that the applicant(s) has no grievance against the O.P./Company at present. A xerox copy of the said cheque for full and final settled amount was marked as Exbt. 2. An original money receipt has been filed to that effect and marked as Exbt. C. Considered.

The Memorandum of Settlement filed by the parties dated 21.06.2024 have duly been signed by the applicant, Mrs. Champa Devi (P.W.1) and Mr. Shantanu Saha (O.P.W.1) (Representative of the O.P./Company) voluntarily. Since the matter has already been settled between the parties to the proceedings, I am of the view that this Tribunal should not stand in the way of their such settlement/compromise, which appears to be legal and valid, and so, this Tribunal finds no impediment in allowing such prayer, made jointly by the parties voluntarily.

Hence, it is

Ordered

that the settlement between the parties is allowed and accordingly, the proceedings under Section 2A(2) of the Industrial Disputes Act, 1947, as amended, be and the same is disposed of in terms of the Memorandum of Settlement dated 21.06.2024. The Memorandum of Settlement dated 21.06.2024 be made part of the Award.

This is my Award.
